

Update 5/10/20

There has been further guidance by the LTA following the changes in restrictions which have been implemented over the past week.

The website has these updates in full. Please do read them as if you do not comply with them when at the club you may be asked to leave.

The main latest changes in addition to the ones I sent last week are:

1. Anyone over the age of 11 entering the clubhouse must wear a face covering.
2. For social tennis session when changing groups after 8 games you must sanitise your hands. You will need to bring your own sanitiser.

I have had to write delivery plans for all social sessions (these will also be in place for coaching sessions) in order to continue to be COVID secure. Part of this is that we are making sure we keep accurate records of people attending these sessions. A committee member or volunteer has been assigned to each session to ensure these records are kept and to remind people about social distancing/hand sanitising as necessary.

You must register before attending any social session, please do not just turn up. If you do you will be asked to leave.

If you register for a session and then can not attend just email roundhaytennis@gmail.com to let us know as we can then release the spot and it helps us keep accurate records. This includes if you don't want to attend because of the weather. Social sessions are not cancelled for weather. I would rather not have to spend my time chasing people who have not attended and not let us know. These are guidelines to keep the club open and social sessions running.
